During my time as both a trial lawyer and a martial artist, I have had a significant amount of experience and exposure to the application of defensive tactics in the law enforcement and business communities. The need for an effective program in the area for conflict resolution with both physical and psychological tactics is of paramount importance to any police/security enforcement. The abilities of the representative of police/security enforcement to effectively resolve these conflicts can have considerable financial impact.
